

Notice for Outpatient Rehabilitation Patients

Face Masks Required

To help prevent the spread of infectious diseases, we kindly ask for your cooperation.

- If you have symptoms such as a cough or runny nose when you arrive, please note that the physician may determine that you are not able to receive rehabilitation services after your pre-rehabilitation medical assessment.
- Please refrain from attending with family members who are feeling unwell.
- A maximum of two accompanying persons is permitted for each outpatient rehabilitation patient.

Rehabilitation Will Be Cancelled in the Following Cases

COVID-19

- 1 The outpatient is diagnosed with COVID-19.
(For 5 days from the onset of symptoms.)
- 2 The patient's class or grade is under temporary closure due to an outbreak.
- 3 A family member living with the outpatient is diagnosed with COVID-19.
(For 5 days from the family member's onset of symptoms.)

Influenza

- 1 The outpatient is diagnosed with influenza.
(From the onset of symptoms until at least 5 days have passed and at least 2 days have passed since the fever resolved. For preschool children, at least 3 days after the fever has resolved.)
- 2 The patient's class or grade is under temporary closure due to an outbreak.
- 3 A family member living with the outpatient is diagnosed with influenza.
(For 5 days from the family member's onset of symptoms.)
- 4 If a student in the same class as the outpatient has tested positive for influenza or COVID-19.

If, upon arrival, your temperature is 37.0°C (98.6°F) or higher and you have symptoms such as a cough, runny nose, or sneezing, your rehabilitation session will be cancelled.

If you are able to receive rehabilitation services, you will be asked to disinfect your hands, wear a face mask, and maintain a distance of at least 2–3 meters (6–10 feet) from others during your session.

If You Are Diagnosed with COVID-19, Influenza, or Another Infectious Disease

If you are diagnosed with COVID-19, influenza, or another infectious disease within 3 days after receiving rehabilitation services, we kindly ask that you contact our facility as soon as possible.
